## School Contribution and Charges for 2024

Dear parents and carers

Our School Board has endorsed this schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2024 as per the School Education Regulations 2000 as part of the School Education Act 1999. The schedule on page 2 provides the estimated maximum costs of activities that may occur throughout the coming school year. The schedule is made up of the following areas:

### 1. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

The State Government sets a maximum amount for voluntary contributions public schools are allowed to request from parents. This has been set at \$60 per child for 2024. These yearly contributions from you are an important revenue source for the school that allows us to pay for the extra learning materials and consumables we need that unfortunately do not fit within the budget we are allocated from the Department of Education. We always keep this to a minimum and we have outlined where your money will go and what it will allow us to achieve over the page. Payments can be made directly to the school or via the Campion 2024 Requirements List.

### 2. BULK PAYMENT (CHARGES FOR ALL EXTRA COST OPTIONAL COMPONENTS)

Children can engage in a variety of activities such as incursions, excursions, swimming lessons, sports carnivals, choir and Edu Dance for which charges will be incurred. Information regarding the school's bulk payment method and Schedule for Charges is outlined over the page.

### 3. ADDITIONAL CONTRIBUTIONS

**Parents & Citizens:** The P&C is requesting parents make a \$50 voluntary contribution per child. The P&C supports the school financially and helps build our community. Some of the support they were involved with in 2023 include supplying a new PA system, iPads, decodable readers for each classroom and organising events e.g. school disco.

**Library Fund:** The school invites parents to make a voluntary \$15 (tax deductible) contribution to the school's **Tax Deductible Gift Recipient Library Fund**. Funds are used to replace and increase the number of computers/tablets in the library. Fremantle Primary is registered as a Tax-Deductible Gift Recipient for our DGR Library Fund.
